The Redevelopment Authority of Somerset County will receive sealed bids for the installation of New Meter Pits with New Meters in the Village of Gray, Jenner Township, Contract No. JT-17-18 METER, Somerset County, Pa. Bids will be received until 2:00 P.M., prevailing time, on the 30th day of September 2020, at the Authority's office located at 300 N. Center Avenue, Suite 520, Somerset, PA 15501. All bids will be opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M., prevailing time, the same date, at the Authority's office. Bids are invited on the following:

The contract shall include the excavation, installation, and restoration of approximately 120 new coil type meter pits and new meters and all necessary appurtenances, located in the Village of Gray, in the Township of Jenner, Somerset County, Pennsylvania.

A pre-bid conference **will not** be held. All questions shall be addressed written, via E-mail to Walter Walerysiak, Jr. of the Redevelopment Authority at [wally@somersetredevelopment.org](mailto:wally@somersetredevelopment.org); and answered as an addendum.

Contract documents and technical specifications are on file and can be reviewed and obtained from the Redevelopment Authority of Somerset County, **by appointment**, or obtained PDF by E-mail. Phone number for appointments or documents (814) 442-7652 or (814) 443-2780.

Addenda, if any, will be issued only to those persons whose name and address are on record with the Owner as having obtained the Contract Documents.

**Davis Bacon prevailing wage rates may be applicable if the total cost of the contract exceeds \$25,000. These are included with the bid documents.**

A certified check or bank draft payable to the order of the Redevelopment Authority of Somerset County, negotiable U.S. Government Bond (at par value) or a satisfactory Bid Bond, executed by the Bidder and an acceptable surety, in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total of the Bid shall also be submitted with each bid.

The successful bidder must furnish 100% Performance, Labor and Materialmen's Bond before awarding the Contract. Attention is called to the fact that the Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, age, color, religion, sex, national origin, or handicap and to the greatest extent feasible, opportunities for employment be given to the lower income residents of the project area. The Contractor shall also utilize project area businesses located in or owned in substantial part by project area residents.

Attention is also directed to the Executive Order 11625 and 12138, the Contractor, in performance of this contract shall, to the greatest extent feasible, utilize minority and or women-owned business concerns which are located within the municipality, county or the general trade area.

Bids may be held by the Owner for a period not to exceed 30 days from the date of opening of bids for the purpose of reviewing the Bids and investigating the qualifications of the Bidders, prior to awarding of the Contract.
