These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for an activity to be undertaken by the County of Somerset.

**REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS**

On or about June 21, 2022, the County of Somerset (County) will submit a request to the PA Department of Community and Economic Development for the release of federal Community Development Block Grant funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (P.L. 93-383), as amended, to fund the 1017 South Center Avenue sewer connection, Somerset Township, Somerset County.

**ASSESSED ACTIVITY**

**Project Description:** Sewer Connection, **Somerset Township**, Somerset County. Somerset Township proposes to connect 1017 South Center Avenue to the public sewer system. A gravity sewer line will be extended from 1017 S. Center Avenue to the Somerset Borough's sanitary collection line located less than 500 feet from the property.

**Project Location:** 1017 South Center Avenue, Somerset Township, Somerset County

**Estimated Funding:** FY 2021 CDBG

**Estimated Total HUD Funded Approximate Amount:** \$80,000

**Mitigation Measures and Conditions:** No mitigation measures required

**Project Beginning & Ending:** Start: September 2022; Completion: January 2023

**FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT**

The County has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) of 1969 is not required. All comments received by June 20, 2022, will be considered by the County prior to authorizing submission of a Request for Release of Funds. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION**

The County certifies to DCED that Gerald Walker, certifying officer, in his capacity as Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, consents to accept the jurisdiction of the federal courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. DCED's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the County to use Program funds.

### OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

DCED will accept objections to its release of funds and Somerset County's certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the County's Certifying Officer; (b) the County has omitted a step or failed to make a determination or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by DCED; or (d) another federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to: Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development at [chrhowe@pa.gov](mailto:chrhowe@pa.gov). Potential objectors should contact DCED to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
